Information/Discussion/Action to consider amending action taken at the March 31, 2009, Board of Supervisors' meeting approving a settlement to resolve tax appeals: BHP Copper v. Gila County et al., TX2008-000482 and Washington Group International v. Gila County et al., TX2008-000481, which would have the combined effect of amending the properties' 2009 full cash value and limited property value from \$208,492,846 to \$178,492,846 and a loss of approximately \$657,000 in tax revenues. The actual effect of the settlement would have the combined effect of amending the properties' 2009 full cash value and limited property value from \$217,700,000 to \$187,700,000 and a loss of approximately \$657,000 in tax revenues. **(Amended)**
