

## GILA COUNTRY FAIRGROUNDS RV PARK POLICIES

### I. Entry, Use, Occupation and Fees

The following acts are prohibited in the Gila County Fairgrounds RV Park:

- A. The entering, using, or occupying of public parks or recreation areas under the supervision and control of the Gila County Fairgrounds Department for any purpose when said parks or areas posted against such entrance, use or occupancy.
- B. Entering or using for any purpose, the land, water or facilities within the boundaries of the Gila County Fairgrounds RV Park when a fee, rental, admission or other consideration has been established for such land, water, or facilities, unless the person using such land, water, or facilities has paid a fee, rental, admission or other such consideration. Permits are non transferable.
- C. Use of Park water to wash vehicles and watercraft is prohibited.
- D. Sheds, fences, skirting, dog houses, outbuildings, containers or any type of storage or improvements erected without prior approval of the Fairgrounds Manager.
- E. Quiet hours are from 10:00 pm to 6:00 am. There should be NO generators, loud music or excessive noise that can be heard from a distance of at least 20 feet. Offensive parties may be cited and/or evicted.

### II. Animals and Pets

The following acts are prohibited in the Gila County Fairgrounds RV Park:

- A. Possessing, allowing or permitting an animal in a County park or recreation area unless the animal is under the immediate control of a leash or other type of restraint.
- B. Allowing dogs and/or other animals to create a nuisance, noise or disturbance in any area within park boundaries.
- C. No animal shall be tied up and left unattended at any time.
- D. No more than two pets are allowed per site.
- E. Owners must immediately dispose of animal waste in trash receptacles.

### III. Firearms, Hunting and Trapping Policy

The following acts are prohibited in the Gila County Fairgrounds RV Park:

- A. Possessing a firearm, unless unloaded in both barrel and magazine in any county facility.
- B. Shooting a firearm, air rifle, air pistol, slingshot, or shooting with bow and arrow, or setting traps within the Parks boundaries without first obtaining a special use permit.
- C. Firearms may be transported or stored in a vehicle within the Park as allowed by A.R.S. 13.
- D. Firearms and weapons must be under lock and key and **not visible** at all times.

#### IV. Vandalism

The following acts are prohibited in the Gila County Fairgrounds RV Park:

- A. Destroying, damaging, removing any tree, shrub, wildflower, cactus, or any other vegetative product or by-product.
- B. Destroying, damaging, defacing or removing any County property or property administered by the department.

#### V. Littering

The following acts are prohibited in the Gila County Fairgrounds RV Park:

- A. Using park trash receptacles for depositing or abandoning garbage, sewage, refuse, trash, waste, or other obnoxious material outside of trash receptacles within the Park. A large dumpster is located in the park for trash. A receptacle for aluminum is also provided to encourage recycling.
- B. Throwing or breaking any glass, plastic, or ceramic object leaving shards or other fragments on Park property.
- C. Depositing or abandoning household garbage, sewage, refuse, trash, waste, or other obnoxious material not produced as a direct result of camping, picnicking, or other such authorized activity within the Park. Such use of receptacles or containers provided for Park visitors constitutes a violation of this ordinance.

#### VI. Public Behavior

Be considerate of others in the park. The areas around each RV is for that persons use and others should go around, not through, their space.

The following acts are prohibited in the Gila County Fairgrounds RV Park:

- C. Conducting oneself in a disorderly or intoxicated manner, or using threatening, abusive, boisterous or insulting language or gestures, or conducting or participating in a disorderly assembly or solicitation for any purpose.
- D. Engaging in noisy conduct, operating generators or motors, operating radios or otherwise making loud or disturbing noises that may disturb the peace of the area between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. or at other times as determined by park staff.
- E. Drying laundry, washing dishes or cleaning fish at campsites, near potable water supplies or restrooms.

#### VII. Fires

The following acts are prohibited in the Gila County Fairgrounds RV Park:

- a. Open fires. BBQ grills must be charcoal or propane only.
- b. Allowing a fire to escape from control.

- c. In case of windy and/or dry condition, a “No Fire” restriction will be imposed and remain in effect until it is deemed safe to allow campfires.

#### VIII. Public or Commercial Activities

The following acts are prohibited in the Gila County Fairgrounds RV Park:

- a. Holding a group activity or assembly on the premises.
- b. Posting, placing, or disturbing material; erecting a fence or barrier, constructing or occupying improvements; or enclosing County administered lands.
- c. Using a loud speaker, or public address system or amplifier.
