### **ASSISTANCE CENTER IN GILA COUNTY CHANGES LOCATION** *Citizens with Unmet Needs Can Still Get Information, Help*

(PHOENIX) –Gila County residents who still have concerns or issues regarding the severe winter storms in January can continue to get assistance.

Effective March 10, 2010, Gila County citizens with disaster-related needs or questions about recovery are urged to visit the newly relocated State Individual Assistance Service Center at the Tonto Basin Kiwanis Community Center, 227 Old Highway 188 in the Punkin Center Business District, Tonto Basin, AZ 85553.

Hours are 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Wednesday-Saturday. The telephone number is 928-978-3141.

Visitors are asked to bring identification and to be prepared to describe their need.

Parts of the area near Punkin Center, Tonto Basin and Gisela in Gila County were acutely impacted by record precipitation. Preliminary Damage Assessments for Individual Assistance were done in the area to assess damage to residential and commercial properties and identify unresolved needs.
