FILING INSTRUCTIONS**

1. File the following documents between April 30 and May 30, 2012, at 5:00 p.m.

**Partisan Nomination Paper
Partisan Nomination Petition(s)**

2. Documents must be filed with the Gila County Department of Elections at our NEW address:

- Filing may be done by mail or in person.
- Documents will be considered filed on the date received in the elections office. Mail early in the event of delivery delays.
- Filing will not be accepted by fax or postmark.
- Partial filing will not be accepted.

3. Nomination Petitions: The candidate must file at least the minimum and no more than the maximum number of signatures required for the office. (Signature Requirements). If there are too few signatures, the filing will not be accepted. A petition does not have to contain 15 signatures.

4. Before Filing the Petitions - Check the Following:

- The circulator portion on the back side is completed and signed. Notarization is not required.
- The elector signature lines on the front side of each petition are complete.

5. Nomination Paper: Make sure to answer every question and fill in every blank.

- Insert the candidate's name exactly how it is to appear on the ballot.
- The candidate's last name appears first, then the first name. A middle or nickname is optional.
- Nicknames are permissible as long as they do not suggest a title.
- The candidate must sign the form and have their signature notarized.*

* Election's office staff will notarize free of charge. The signer must sign in person and present picture identification. Additional forms are available at the Gila County Elections office.
