Since 1881, there have been 71 different men & women who have served as Supervisors for Gila County.

Did you know...

Three Supervisors served more than one separate terms in office. They included Supervisors: David Devore (1895-1899 & 1903-1914), F. W. Westmeyer (1881-1887 & 1897-1897), and George Danforth (1881-1882 & 1889-1890).

Did you know...

Charles Curnow, our 53rd Supervisor, had the longest term served as a Supervisor. He was in office from 1933-1956. That's an astounding 24 years!!

Did you know...

Florence Louise McGoey, was the first woman to serve as a Supervisor for Gila County. After her husband J. J. McGoey, Gila County Supervisor from 1955-1963, fell ill during his term, she took over and finished out his term. She served from 1963-1965.

The office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors has in their vault all the official minutes of past Board Meetings, including the original handwritten minutes from the very first Gila County Board of Supervisor's Meeting, which took place on March 5, 1881.
