Gila County Elections Facts

Mission: To ensure equal access to the electoral process for all candidates and citizens by conducting secure elections that ensure every vote counts; implementing nondiscriminatory programs which encourage all citizens to vote; and providing superior training programs for citizen volunteers.

Did you know...

In 2012, there were a total of 32,161 registered voters in Gila County and 21,823 residents voted, a 67.86% voter turnout! Gila County was ranked 8th among all Arizona counties.

Did you know...

During the November 6, 2012 election, 16 early ballots were rejected due to mismatched signatures, some had already voted and a few voted on the wrong ballot. There were 266 rejected provisional ballots.

Did you know...

Gila County has more than 200 poll workers deployed on Election Day. You may sign up to be a poll worker today by contacting the department.

Did you know...

To be eligible for an election, you must register to vote at least 29 days before the election. You can mail or hand deliver your completed form to the County Recorder's office or you can register online at www.azsos.gov

Did you know...

Gila County has a total of 175 elected officials within the County.
