The Public Works Department assumes diverse duties and activities guiding and assisting the following departments: Administration, Engineering, Facilities, Fleet Vehicle and Equipment Services, Recycling & Landfill Management, and Consolidated Roads & Auto Equipment Maintenance for the Gila County Maintained Roadway System.



Did you know...

The Auto/Equipment Maintenance is responsible for service and maintenance for the entire County fleet, which includes vehicles, heavy equipment, trucks, machinery, generators, and trash pumps for fire suppression support. This department is vital to the day to day operation to the Sheriff's Office, Road Department, Recycling and Landfill, besides other County departments, and are available to respond to emergency breakdowns.

Did you know...

The Adopt-a-Road program is a national litter awareness program. Gila County residents participate by volunteering to pick up litter off of Gila County's Roadway System. Volunteers may include civic, community, church and business groups and even families. The Adopt-a-Road program offers several benefits to the community by providing a clean environment, giving civic pride to the community, serving as a reminder not to litter and saving taxpayers money.

Gila County owns or maintains a total of 765 miles of roadways. There are approximately 172 miles of paved roadways and 593 miles of unpaved roadways.
