Item 1 – Call to Order

The Gila County Board of Supervisors met in an emergency session at 2:45 p.m. this date in the Board of Supervisors hearing room.

Item 2 - Information/Discussion/Action to adopt Resolution No. 12-06-07 declaring a state of emergency in Gila County due to the occurrence of the Poco Fire located 6 miles northeast of Young, Arizona.

Prior to the beginning of this meeting, each Board member was apprised of the status of the Poco Fire. Chairman Martin read aloud the Resolution into the record and then asked for a motion.
