**A RESOLUTION OF THE GILA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
ACCEPTING THE GRANT OF A HIGHWAY EASEMENT DEED FROM  
THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION,  
FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION FOR FOREST ROAD 199,  
ALSO KNOWN AS HOUSTON MESA ROAD**

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration has agreed to grant Gila County a one-hundred foot wide Highway Easement Deed; and




