A RESOLUTION OF THE GILA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SUPPORTING NATIONAL COMMUNITY HEALTH PARTNERS' SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS THAT WOULD PROVIDE TRADITIONAL HOUSING FOR QUALIFIED VETERANS THROUGH THE "HOUSING FOR HEROES" PROJECT.

WHEREAS, veterans are more vulnerable to homelessness and the number of homeless veterans has dramatically risen in the past two years; and

WHEREAS, the Gila County Board of Supervisors is fully cognizant of the fact and recognizes the need to address the issue and play a major role in finding a solution to assist these veterans and veteran families; and

WHEREAS, National Community Health Partners has identified a funding source that addresses homelessness with veterans; and


WHEREAS, the Gila County Board of Supervisors recognizes the opportunity to support National Community Health Partners' proposal to the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Gila County Board of Supervisors fully supports the National Community Health Partners' submission of a grant application to the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs that would provide traditional housing for qualified veterans through the "Housing for Heroes" Project in order to assist homeless veterans in Gila County.


