**RESOLUTION NO. 08-05-03**

**WHEREAS**, on April 1, 1991, the Gila County Board of Supervisors adopted a Street Naming and Property Numbering Ordinance to provide for the uniform assignment of property numbers; and,

**WHEREAS**, street names are assigned in order to implement the uniform assignment of property numbers and avoid duplicate names that would hinder emergency services and the safety of Gila County residents; and,

**WHEREAS**, Article 8, Section 806, of the Street Naming and Property Numbering Ordinance provides guidelines for the renaming of existing streets; and,

**WHEREAS**, the following street name and location substantially complies with the provisions of Article 8 of the Ordinance.


**PEACEFUL LANE-SEC.24, T.9N, R10E**


