RESOLUTION

No. 08-06-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE GILA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR THE EXTINGUISHMENT OF AN EASEMENT PURSUANT TO ARIZONA REVISED STATUTE 28-7214.

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §28-7214 authorizes the Gila County Board of Supervisors to extinguish by resolution easements that are no longer necessary for public use; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Gila County to extinguish a portion of a roadway easement as shown at Book 60 Real Estate Deeds, Page 58, Gila County Records, also shown on Record of Survey Map No. 58 and Record of Survey Map No. 3564, Gila County Records, Gila County, AZ. and,

WHEREAS, the portion of the roadway easement is more particularly described as the West twenty five (25.00) feet of the South one thousand three hundred forty (1340.00) feet of that easement shown on Record of Survey Map No. 3564, Gila County Records, and,

WHEREAS, public utility easements for the following shall continue as they existed before the roadway extinguishment, existing sewer, gas, water or similar pipelines and appurtenances. Canals, laterals or ditches and appurtenances. Electric, telephone and similar lines and appurtenances, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Gila County Board of Supervisors that Gila County's right and interest in the roadway portion of the easement described above be extinguished.


