ADOPTION OF HOUSING SERVICES PROGRAM GUIDELINES

RESOLUTION NO. 09-06-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF GILA, AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF HOUSING SERVICES PROGRAM GUIDELINES DATED **June 23, 2009** IN RELATION TO AN APPLICATION FOR FY 2009 STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOR A HOUSING REHABILITATION ACTIVITY.

WHEREAS, Gila County is desirous of undertaking an owner occupied housing rehabilitation program; and

WHEREAS, This program is funded with Community Development Block Grant Program funds provided by the State of Arizona CDBG Program, and

WHEREAS, the State CDBG Program requires that every local government requesting CDBG funds for housing rehabilitation adopt specific guidelines for such a program; and


WHEREAS, Gila County has developed such owner occupied housing rehabilitation guidelines, dated **June 23, 2009** which have been pre-approved by the CDBG Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Gila County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts such OO-HRGs, dated **June 23rd, 2009** , which shall be used to implement its CDBG-funded housing rehabilitation program funded through its application for FY 2009 funds; and

THAT, Gila County shall utilize such OO-HRGs, without revisions except such authorized by the chief elected official or a person authorized in writing to approve such revisions via the CDBG Program's CD-1Form; with such revisions submitted to the CDBG Program within a maximum of 10 working days of authorization.
