RESOLUTION NO. 09-10-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF GILA COUNTY, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING THE CONTINUATION OF THE GILA COUNTY SPECIFIED ENTERPRISE ZONE FOR AN ADDITIONAL FIVE YEARS AND URGING THE ARIZONA STATE LEGISLATURE TO PRESERVE FUNDING FOR THE ENTERPRISE ZONE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, A.R.S § 41-1521 through 41-1528 authorized the establishment of enterprise zones in Arizona; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Gila County is concerned about high unemployment and poverty in the County in a number of census tracts; and,

WHEREAS, six (6) census tracts have been identified within the County as the Gila County Specified Enterprise Zone; and,

WHEREAS, the Gila County Specified Enterprise Zone Program has benefited Gila County by providing incentives to businesses and industries locating within the Specified Enterprise Zone; and,

WHEREAS, the Gila County Board of Supervisors has seen that tax credits and property tax benefits have directly resulted in increased job creation and capital investment within the Specified Enterprise Zone.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Gila County Board of Supervisors wholeheartedly supports the continuation of the Gila County Specified Enterprise Zone for an additional 5 years, from October 27, 2009, through October 26, 2014, and it urges the Arizona State Legislature to preserve funding for the Enterprise Zone Program.
