



**RESOLUTION NO. 10-02-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE GILA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DESIGNATING THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF MIAMI AS A COLONIA WITHIN GILA COUNTY.**

**WHEREAS**, a "Colonia" development as defined by the United States Department of Agriculture has occurred in the incorporated Town of Miami, Gila County, Arizona; and

**WHEREAS**, incorporated or unincorporated communities within the County that lack adequate potable water supplies, adequate sewage systems, and/or decent, safe and sanitary housing are eligible for designation as a Colonia; and

**WHEREAS**, designation as a Colonia is necessary before certain state and federal funds can be made available to improve infrastructure and housing within this community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Gila County Board of Supervisors designates the incorporated Town of Miami as a Colonia because it lacks an adequate potable water supply, adequate sewage system, and/or decent, safe and sanitary housing.
