RESOLUTION NO. 10-05-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE GILA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DESIGNATING THE COBRE VALLEY SANITARY DISTRICT AS A COLONIA WITHIN GILA COUNTY.

WHEREAS, a "Colonia" development as defined by the United States Department of Agriculture has occurred in the Cobre Valley Sanitary District, Gila County, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, incorporated or unincorporated communities within the County that lack adequate potable water supplies, adequate sewage systems, and/or decent, safe and sanitary housing are eligible for designation as a Colonia; and

WHEREAS, designation as a Colonia is necessary before certain state and federal funds can be made available to improve infrastructure and housing within this community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Gila County Board of Supervisors designates the Cobre Valley Sanitary District as a Colonia because it lacks an adequate potable water supply, adequate sewage system, and/or decent, safe and sanitary housing.
