RESOLUTION NO. 10-08-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF GILA, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING A LETTER TO THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ARIZONA AND A LETTER TO THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) IN OPPOSITION TO THE EPA'S RECENT PROPOSAL TO DESIGNATE THE AREA OF HAYDEN, ARIZONA, AS BEING IN NONATTAINMENT OF THE NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARD (NAAQS) FOR LEAD.

WHEREAS, on or around June 2010, the EPA published a proposal to designate the area of Hayden, Arizona, including portions of Gila County, as being in nonattainment of the NAAQS for lead;

WHEREAS, the Gila County Board of Supervisors, on December 1, 2009, passed a resolution opposing the nonattainment proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed or been made aware of portions of the administrative record underlying the nonattainment proposal and, based thereon, remains in opposition to the nonattainment proposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:


1. The Board authorizes the submission of a letter on its behalf and on behalf of Gila County to the Governor of the State of Arizona requesting that the Governor file with the EPA an objection to the nonattainment proposal; and
2. The Board authorizes the Supervisors to develop a comment letter or letters in opposition to the nonattainment proposal, and directs that the comment letter(s) be filed with the EPA by the deadline applicable to the filing of comment letters concerning the proposal, which as of the date of this Resolution is August 16, 2010.
