RESOLUTION NO. 11-01-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF GILA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY WITHIN GILA COUNTY AS A RESULT OF HEAVY RAIN AND SNOWFALL CAUSING FLOOD CONDITIONS, POWER OUTAGES, AND ISOLATED CONDITIONS.

WHEREAS, rain and snow storms that started on December 28, 2010 are continuing to occur and as of December 31, 2010, have caused damage to public and private structures and roads within Gila County; and

WHEREAS, these storms have resulted in a condition of peril to the health and safety of many citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Gila County Board of Supervisors is authorized by resolution of the Board to declare an emergency.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Gila County Board of Supervisors declares that an emergency now exists in Gila County resulting in the following:

- a. The Gila County Emergency Operations Plan is hereby activated and in effect until further notice; and
- b. During this emergency, local government agencies assigned emergency roles in the Gila County Emergency Plan are an Emergency Organization of the County; and
- c. Mutual aid from appropriate agencies is hereby requested.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Matt Bolinger, Division Director of Health and Emergency Services, is authorized to execute for and on behalf of Gila County any documents for the purpose of obtaining certain Federal and State financial assistance under the Disaster Relief Act (Public Law 288, 93rd Congress) and the appropriate Arizona Revised Statutes, or assistance which is otherwise available from the President's Disaster Relief fund.
