A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF GILA COUNTY, ARIZONA EXPRESSING CONTINUED SUPPORT FOR THE COBRE VALLEY COMMUNITY TRANSIT PROGRAM FROM OCTOBER 1, 2011, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2012

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Gila County has determined that maintaining adequate and affordable public transportation is essential in the Greater Globe-Miami area; and

WHEREAS, the preservation, improvement and expansion of public transportation services in the Greater Globe-Miami area is in the best interest of the community; and

WHEREAS, public transportation is a regional resource, improving the quality of life for all residents of the Greater Globe-Miami area and

WHEREAS, existing local funding sources and mechanisms do not provide adequate resources to maintain or expand current transportation services; and



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Gila County Board of Supervisors of Gila County hereby:


