RESOLUTION NO. 12-07-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE GILA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, AUTHORIZING COUNTY STAFF TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ADOT), FOR A PLANNING ASSISTANCE FOR RURAL AREAS (PARA) STUDY FOR GILA COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Planning Assistance for Rural Areas (PARA) is sponsored by ADOT Multimodal Planning Division (MPD); and,

WHEREAS, the PARA program is used to address a broad range of local and regional planning issues related to roadway, transit, and non-motorized transportation modes for counties, cities, towns, and tribal governments: and,

WHEREAS, Gila County is desirous of a PARA program to assist in guidance and programming for future transportation needs of Gila County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Gila County Board of Supervisors:

SECTION 1: The Gila County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes staff to submit and execute an application for the purpose of a PARA study for Gila County.

SECTION 2: Gila County hereby certifies that Gila County will comply with all appropriate procedures, guidelines, and requirements established by Arizona Department of Transportation as part of the PARA Program.

SECTION 3: Gila County hereby certifies that Gila County will comply with all appropriate state and federal regulations, policies, guidelines and requirements as they relate to the PARA Program.






