



**RESOLUTION NO. 15-03-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE GILA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2015 STATE HOUSING FUND (SHF) PROGRAM FUNDS, WHICH MAY INCLUDE FEDERAL FUNDING THROUGH THE HOME PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM OR SHF; CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATION MEETS THE COMMUNITY'S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE SHF PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATION.**

**WHEREAS**, the Gila County Board of Supervisors is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Arizona is administering the SHF program; and

**WHEREAS**, the activities outlined within this application address the community's low and moderate income population housing needs; and

**WHEREAS**, recipients of funds from the SHF program are required to comply with the program guidelines, and state and federal statutes and regulations.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Gila County Board of Supervisors authorizes an application to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Housing for FY 2015 State Housing Fund program funds; authorizes its Chairman to sign the application and contract or grant documents for receipt and use of these funds for housing rehabilitation; and 3) authorizes its Chairman to take all actions necessary to implement and complete the activities submitted in said application; and







