



RESOLUTION NO. 15-05-03

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GILA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND THE TONTO APACHE TRIBE FOR THE DETENTION AND CARE OF DETAINEES DETAINED UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF A TRIBAL COURT ORDER OF THE TONTO APACHE TRIBE AT THE GILA COUNTY DETENTION FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the Gila County Sheriff's Office (GCSO) and the Tonto Apache Tribe (Tribe), a federally recognized Indian Tribe pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; (48 Stat. 984), are desirous of entering into an Intergovernmental Service Agreement whereby the GCSO will provide for the detention and care of detainees detained under the authority of a Tribal Court Order of the Tonto Apache Tribe at the Gila County Detention Facility; and,

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Services Agreement between the GCSO and the Tribe requires each entity's governing body to adopt a resolution which authorizes the execution of the Intergovernmental Services Agreement.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Gila County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the execution of an Intergovernmental Services Agreement between the GCSO and the Tribe for the detention and care of detainees detained under the authority of a Tribal Court Order of the Tonto Apache Tribe at the Gila County Detention Facility.
