

Option 3 -- To Request a Hearing by Mail

Complete the following **ONLY** if you wish to contest the charge(s) before a judge or hearing officer. *Note: Setting a hearing results in the loss of your privilege to attend a defensive driving class for violation dismissal.*

1. Write the complaint number that appears in the upper left hand corner of your citation in the spaces provided below, and **indicate the charges for which you want to set a hearing by circling the letter that corresponds to that charge on your citation.**

6. You will be notified by mail of your hearing date. You must appear on the date assigned by the court.

* A.R.S. 28-645A3A & 28-647.1-State Law Requires all persons to attend Traffic Survival School (TSS) who are found responsible for a red light or flashing red light violation, unless they are eligible and attend Defensive Driving School. If you are required to attend TSS, you will receive notice from the Motor Vehicle Division (MVD) that will provided specific information on school locations, dates, and times.

Your citation has a notation that identifies it as either civil or criminal. If you received a criminal citation, you must contact the court for instructions. This bond card contains information for those who have received civil citations.

The following information describes the three options available to you for the citation you received, or you may appear in court at the date and time shown above your signature on your citation. If you have multiple charges on your citation, you will need to indicate your choice for each charge, whether option 1, 2, or 3.

Failure to appear in court on the date listed on your citation, or failure to complete one of the other options listed below may result in the issuance of a warrant for your arrest, a driver license suspension, and/or additional monetary costs being imposed.

Option 1 -- Defensive Driving Program

Arizona statutes provide that under certain circumstances, a person may divert a traffic violation (one charge or violation) through attendance at a defensive driving class. If you choose to attend:

1. You need not appear in court for that charge.
2. The charge will be dismissed.
3. No fine will be assessed for the charge.
4. No points are added to your driving record for the charge.

Eligibility:

You may be eligible for diversion of a charge through completion of a defensive driving class if you have not attended a defensive driving class for any Arizona violation dated within the immediate twenty-four months prior to the current violation for which you wish to attend, and at least one of the violations you are charged with is a civil traffic moving violation, and your citation was not issued as a result of a collision in which any person was seriously injured or killed, and your case has not already been set for a hearing. All these conditions must be met.

*** You will not be allowed to attend if you have a Commercial Driver's License.**

If you wish to attend, you must do the following:

1. Call 1-888-334-5565 or choose school online at www.azcourts.gov, go to Quick Links: Defensive Driving Schools. The School will determine your eligibility, register you for a class and report your attendance to the court upon completion.
2. Complete the class at least 17 days prior to your court date.
3. Online fee: The fee is determined by the school.
4. Classroom fee: \$168.00; provide a copy of your citation, show your Driver's License or Photo ID to the instructor and pay the class fee by Cashier's Check or Money Order prior to the class.

If you complete the Defensive Driving class, you need not appear at the court on that charge.

If you received multiple charges on your citation, only one can be dismissed through Option 1. You must decide whether to plead responsible for, or request a hearing to contest, each remaining charge. Indicate your choices by completing the sections for Option 2 and/or Option 3 as per the instructions. Make certain you indicate your choice for each remaining charge on your citation.

Option 2 -- Pay your Fine By Mail (Enter a Plea of "Responsible")

If you complete this section you are admitting responsibility for the violation(s). The court will enter a judgement of responsible and will report the findings to the Motor Vehicle Division. Points will be assessed to your driving record for any moving violations.

1. Find your violation code(s) on the attached Fine/Bond schedule, and purchase a cashier's check, or money order for the total amount(s) shown or fill out credit card information on a separate sheet of paper. If your violation code does not appear on the schedule, you must contact the court. Make the cashier's check or money order payable to the PAYSON COURTS. **The Court does not accept cash or personal checks.**
2. Write your complaint number, which appears in the upper left hand corner of your citation, on the money order.

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3. Fill in the payment information (over) **for the charges you wish to plead responsible**. Print the name of the person who received the citation EXACTLY as it appears on the citation.

4. Detach this card, place it and the payment in the envelope provided and affix the correct postage. Mail the payment at least five business days prior to your court date (listed above your signature on the citation).
