Section B. **PURPOSE OF THE RFQ**

1. Intent

It is the intent of Gila County to receive and evaluate Statements of Qualifications and Performance Data from any interested parties to select a short list of the three most qualified firms. The County intends to enter into negotiations with the most qualified person or firm for a Design-Build Contract for the work described in Section F. If such negotiations fail, they will be formally terminated and the County may commence negotiations with the next highest ranked qualified person or firm on the short list.

Section C. INSTRUCTIONS TO RESPONDENTS

No telephonic, telegraphic, or facsimile Responses shall be considered. Responses received after the time for closing shall be returned to the Respondent unopened.

1. Responses shall be submitted in 10 copies.
2. No department, school, or office at the County has the authority to solicit official Responses other than the Finance Department. All solicitation is performed under the direct supervision of the Finance Director and in complete accordance with Gila County policies and procedures.
3. Responding persons or firms may be requested to meet with the selection committee to discuss their Statement of Qualifications and Performance Data. Scheduling of these discussions shall be accomplished by the Public Works Department.
4. Any information considered to be proprietary by the Proposer shall be placed in a separate envelope and marked "Proprietary Information." To the extent the Finance Director concurs, this information shall not be considered public information. The Finance Director is the final authority as to the extent of material which is considered confidential. Pricing information cannot be considered proprietary.
5. Statements of Qualifications and Performance Data shall be submitted in the format shown in Section D.
6. If responding by express mail allow sufficient time for delivery. Globe is considered a rural area, thereby Federal Express deliveries are often made late in the afternoon. Statement of Qualifications may not be faxed nor electronically transmitted to the County. Proposals, which are received after the deadline, will not be considered. Submitters must ensure delivery (not postmarking) by the date and time indicated above.

Section E. QUALIFICATIONS

Arizona Revised Statutes 34-603, pursuant to allows for the procurement of professional and construction services using design build methodology.

This is phase one of a two-phase process. Phase one is based on competence and qualifications only. Discussion with the top three (3) persons or firms MAY be included in the selection process.

Phase one shall not “*request fees, price, man-hours or any other cost information in the selection*”.

1. For consideration the following licenses and certifications shall be required. Copies shall be included:
 - A. Design / Builder shall be a licensed contractor with the Arizona Registrar of Contractors Office.
 - B. Design / Builder shall use current 2012 International Building Code and Arizona State codes as construction, inspection and testing standards.
 - C. Design / Builder shall prove competence to design and installation of stairs and landings, preparation of engineered shop drawings for design and construction of stair and landing systems.
 - D. Employees assigned to this project shall have the necessary technical, theoretical and practical knowledge to fully understand the sequence and consequence of the task and be able to perform safely and properly the job in given conditions (i.e., climbing ladders, maintaining fire egress from the building at all times, protection of pedestrians below and around work area, etc.).
 - E. Design professional shall be a licensed engineer in the State of Arizona to provide design and engineering for stair and landing systems.

2. Additionally, the following information shall be included:

- A. Managerial overview.
- B. Discuss previous design-build experience.
- C. Narrative statements on design and management approaches.
- D. Organizational charts: for company and for this project.
- E. Construction management and quality control plans.
- F. Safety records, procedures and policies.
- G. Qualifications of site superintendent.
- H. Qualifications of other persons to be assigned to design build team.

3. Other items:

- A. Ability to meet insurance requirements. See General Provisions.
- B. Ability to meet bonding requirements. See General Provisions.
- C. If applicable, the contractor shall submit any information relating to company name changes within the last five calendar years, the reason for the name change.
- D. List all projects under contract or completed in the last three (3) years with reference information.
- E. Contractors from out of this region (greater than 30 miles) shall show evidence of successfully managing projects from long distance.

4. Value Engineering

- A. Project specific recommendations
- B. DO NOT include pricing just recommendations

5. Systems Data

System specifications including performance, warranty terms and period for all components of the systems, training provisions, service plan, replacement parts availability / costs and spare parts to be provided list.

6. References

Shall include three (3) design-build references. Be sure to include the name, title, phone number and e-mail of persons able to discuss project(s) in detail.

7. Design and Construction Schedule

- A. The Design / Builder shall submit a schedule, with their proposal, indicating all phases of the design build process. Contractor shall coordinate all work through Gila County's Facility Services Project Manager. Order and sequence of construction shall be done on such schedule as not to disrupt the normal operations of the County, and provide the minimal amount of time at each of the stairways between demo and new installation.
- B. Design / Builder is expected to demonstrate that they can supply adequate qualified personnel in order to meet this completion requirement.

Section F. **REQUIREMENTS**

1. **SCOPE OF WORK**

Remove the existing wooden steps and landings and provide complete new metal steps and landings for the exterior area of the Payson Courthouse. Completely remove the existing wooden steps and landings and replace them with new metal steps and landings on the exterior area of the Courthouse in Payson, AZ. Pictures of existing steps and landings are an attachment to this RFQ. Design / Builder shall be able to provide complete turnkey design and build services.

Proposer shall include any project specific value engineering design recommendations with their proposal. **DO NOT** include any pricing, only recommendations.

2. The contractor is expected to carefully examine the site of the proposed work, the Request for Qualifications, plans, specifications, and contract forms. He shall satisfy himself as to the character, quality, and quantities of work to be performed, materials to be furnished, and as to the requirements of the proposed contract.

Work is tentatively scheduled to occur as follows:

Award: June 9, 2015
Design: 2 weeks
Approval: 2 weeks
Fabrication & Construction: 6 weeks maximum

Proposer shall provide a schedule with their proposal submittal. Only one stairway shall be unusable at any given time. Schedule shall show projected down time duration for each stairway.

3. **TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS**

A. **General Requirements**

- i. **Project is located in a heavily used main entry courtyard to the Gila County Courts. Weekend and after business hours work is advisable for safety reasons. Only one stairway shall be unusable at any given time.**
- ii. All work shall be conducted so as to minimize disturbance to the occupants of the buildings and protection of the pedestrians in the courtyard area.
- iii. Safety and good housekeeping practices shall be emphasized. Pick up and dispose of construction debris daily.
- iv. During the design and construction, the contractor shall consider the existing and historical conditions. Design and Construction methods shall be employed to minimize identifiable damage or disturbance to the buildings and contents. Notify building users and Facility Services Project Manager of any conditions of concern or hazard before disturbance.

B. Inspection And Testing

- i. Design / Builder shall coordinate inspection schedule with the appropriate personnel.

C. Closeout Submittals And Requirements

- i. Completed "As Built" drawings, sealed by the Engineer.
- ii. O&M specifications and warranty for all systems and parts
- iii. Spare Parts and any special tools required

Section G. **EVALUATION CRITERIA**

1. Responses shall be evaluated on the following basis:

- a. Qualifications and competency of contractor and site superintendent 25 points
- b. Demonstrated expertise in projects of similar size and type: 15 points
- c. Understanding of requested services and completeness of response 10 points
- d. Value engineering recommendations 15 points
- e. Design and Construction scheduling 20 points
- f. Successful management of projects long distance 10 points
- g. Familiarity with Town of Payson, and experience working in cold weather climate. 5 points

2. In addition:

- a. Ability to meet insurance and bonding requirement
