

# GILA COUNTY ADOPT-A-ROAD PROGRAM



### The Adopt-a-Road Program offers several benefits to its communities

It provides a clean environment, gives civic pride to the community, serves as a reminder not to litter and saves tax-payers money.

## Adopt-a-Road is a program where groups volunteer to pick up litter off of Gila County's Roadway system.

The Adopt-a-Road program is a national litter awareness program. This will give Gila County residents an opportunity to participate in removing litter and save tax-payers money.

Gila County is happy to start this program and get as many residents involved who want to volunteer.

Volunteers may include civic, community, church and business groups and even families.

### WHAT GILA COUNTY PROVIDES TO VOLUNTEERS

- Erect signs identifying the name of the organization
- Safety training for organization coordinators
- Supply litter bags
- Landfill fees waived for disposal of litter bags (or) bags may be brought to the dumpster at the Gila County Courthouse
- Send new organizations Certification of Adoption and newsletters
- Safety vests: Returned once work is complete
- List of approved areas in the program based on safety considerations
- Information concerning traffic volume, speed, curves, and number of intersections
- Recycling opportunities available for groups who wish to use them

### WHAT A VOLUNTEER MUST PROVIDE

- Two (2) year commitment to pick up litter along a designated stretch of highway
- Pick up at litter at least two (2) times per year
- Complete an Adopt-a-Road waiver form signed by each participant in the pickup event
- Hold a safety briefing before litter pickup
- Schedule the date/time of pickup with the County Adopt-a-Road contact
- A Designate a member as a coordinator
- Return a postcard to the County indicating hours worked, number of participants, and number of bags of trash removed
- Complete and return the Adopt-a-Road Application

### SAFETY RULES FOR VOLUNTEERS

- Carpool to pickup location and keep vehicles off travelway and shoulder of road
- Ensure workers wear safety vests provided by the County
- Always face oncoming traffic
- Avoid overexertion
- Stop work in inclement weather
- Do not remove hazardous substances
- Avoid areas where herbicides have been applied
- Avoid contact with noxious weeds
- Do not pick up items on bridges or on pavement
- △ Do not bring children under the age of twelve (12) to the Adopt-a-Road area

- 2. Work shall be conducted during daylight hours.
- 3. Workers shall not cross the traveled way of access controlled highways.
- 4. If weather or other adverse circumstances cause a public hazard, work shall be immediately discontinued.

- 5. Volunteers performing work under this permit shall wear personal protective clothing, including orange vests, while on County right-of-way.
- 6. Work shall not be initiated prior to briefing on safety procedures by County's representative.
- 7. Permittee shall designate a coordinator who shall represent the group. In addition, one (1) adult supervisor shall be assigned by the volunteer organization for each ten (10) children between the ages of twelve (12) and eighteen (18) years of age. No children less than twelve (12) years of age shall be allowed to participate or to remain in the right-of-way assigned to the permittee.
- 8. Participants personal vehicles shall not be parked within the right-of-way of an access controlled road, and on all other roads shall be legally located off the traveled way so as not to interfere with the free flow of traffic or pedestrians; except, approved vehicles(s) used to transport participants or materials to and from the work site may be parked off the roadway on access controlled highways.
- 9. This permit is valid for two (2) calendar years from the date of issue and may be renewed with the Department's approval.
- 10. Each individual shall attend a safety orientation conducted by Gila County prior to entering the County Road right-of-way. The orientation shall include a discussion and explanation of safety requirements.
- 11. Each participant (or parent or guardian of a minor participant) shall sign a waiver form. The permittee has volunteered to pick up litter in the right-of-way at its own risk. Gila County and its officers and employees shall not be liable for any death, injury, or property damage claims and all the costs associated therewith which arise. If any claim arises out of the foregoing, the permittee shall defend, indemnify and save harmless Gila County and its officers and employees from same. Permittees obligation under this Section shall not extend to any liability caused by the sole negligence of Gila County or its employees.
- 12. This permit may be canceled by Gila County for failure to pick up litter per agreement or for non-conformance with other permit provisions. Gila County will provide safety training, litter bags and safety vests. Gila County will erect signs showing the volunteer participant of the named organization in the Adopta-Road Program. The work order for this will be processed as soon as this permit is approved and the sign will be installed in a timely manner.
