

Free webinars offered to individuals interested in running in school board elections

Elections for school boards will be held this November across Arizona. In support of its commitment to quality leadership for Arizona's public schools, the Arizona School Boards Association (ASBA) will be sharing information in three free webinars about the rewards, challenges and legal requirements of board service, primarily geared to those individuals who are considering running for these essential community leadership positions.

The ASBA webinars for individuals who are interested in running for a seat on their local school district governing boards will be held:

- Commonly Asked Questions about Board Service
- Support Available to Board Members Once Elected

The webinars are open to any and all interested individuals statewide. Participants will also have the opportunity to submit questions to be answered live during the webinar.
