




TOTAL CALLS FOR SERVICE




ARRESTS BY CATAGORY









FY2015 ANNUAL BUDGET








FISCAL YEAR 2015 OPERATING BUDGET AND PERSONNEL



IN 2015 A NUMBER OF UPDATES AND IMPROVEMENTS WERE MADE TO SHERIFF'S OFFICE SYSTEMS THAT SUPPORT DEPUTY ACTIVITIES. SPILLMAN MOBILE SOFTWARE WAS ROLLED OUT TO PATROL VEHICLES. THIS ALLOWS EACH DEPUTY TO ACCESS THE COMPUTER AIDED DISPATCHING (CAD) AND MAPPING FROM THEIR VEHICLES. DEPUTIES ARE ABLE TO SEE THE SAME SCREEN THAT DISPATCHERS ARE USING, ALLOWING BOTH DISPATCH AND DEPUTIES IN THE FIELD TO SHARE REAL TIME INFORMATION. THE INSTALLATION OF C-SOFT EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE IN DISPATCH IS ALSO ENHANCING DEPUTIES ABILITY TO MANAGE A MULTI-AGENCY OR MULTIJURISDICTION SCENE BECAUSE DISPATCH CAN CREATE TALK GROUPS FOR SPECIFIC AREAS OF RESPONSE. THIS FUNCTION REDUCES RADIO TRAFFIC WHEN COMMUNICATION NEEDS TO BE CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD.



THE MISSION OF THE PATROL BUREAU IS TO PROTECT AND SERVE THE COMMUNITIES OF GILA COUNTY THROUGH PATROL, EDUCATION, TRAINING AND OTHER COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT THAT REDUCES OR ELIMINATES CRIMINAL ACTIVITY, TEACHES CRIME PREVENTION, AND ENCOURAGES RESIDENTS TO ENJOY SAFE HOMES AND NEIGHBORHOODS.







BOOKINGS BY CLASSIFICATION




DETENTION HEALTH SERVICES BUDGET

THE MISSION OF THE GILA COUNTY ADULT DETENTION CENTERS IS TO CREATE AN ENVIRONMENT THAT PROMOTES COMMUNITY SAFETY, FACILITY SAFETY AND THE WELFARE OF STAFF AND INMATES. OUR GOAL IS THAT FACILITY OPERATIONS COMPLY WITH THE STANDARDS FOR DETENTION FACILITIES SET FORTH BY THE NATIONAL SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION, THE ARIZONA JAIL GUIDELINES AND THE NATIONAL COMMISSION OF CORRECTIONAL HEALTH CARE.

THE EFFECTIVE OPERATIONS OF THE PAYSON AND GLOBE DETENTION CENTERS ARE DEPENDENT ON THE HIGHLY MOTIVATED AND WELL TRAINED MEN AND WOMEN WHO STRIVE TO IMPROVE THEIR INDIVIDUAL JOB PERFORMANCES AS WELL AS THEIR AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY WITHIN THE DETENTION CENTERS. TO ENCOURAGE PROFESSIONAL GROWTH, STAFF MEMBERS ARE PROVIDED TRAINING WITHIN THE DETENTION BUREAU AS WELL AS OPPORTUNITIES TO ATTEND SPECIALIZED TRAINING AT THE STATE AND NATIONAL LEVEL.



TOTAL NUMBER OF CALLS BY PUBLIC SAFETY ANSWERING POINT




DISPATCHING PARTNERSHIPS

AFTER MANY YEARS OF PLANNING, THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE DISPATCH CENTER GLOBE, SOON TO BE KNOWN AS THE COPPER CORRIDOR COMMUNICATIONS CENTER, WAS EQUIPPED AND READY TO OFFER DISPATCHING SERVICES TO THE CITY OF GLOBE. ON SEPTEMBER 21, 2015 GCSO BECAME THE OFFICIAL DISPATCH CENTER FOR GLOBE FIRE AND POLICE DEPARTMENTS.

SINCE THAT TIME GCSO HAS WORKED WITH THESE AGENCIES TO PROVIDE DISPATCH SERVICES WITH EFFICIENCY AND DEPENDABILITY.

NATIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS WEEK

EACH YEAR, THE SECOND FULL WEEK OF APRIL IS DEDICATED TO THE MEN AND WOMEN WHO SERVE AS PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS. IT WAS FIRST CONCEIVED BY PATRICIA ANDERSON OF THE CONTRA COSTA COUNTY (CALIF.) SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN 1981 AND WAS OBSERVED ONLY AT THAT AGENCY FOR THREE YEARS. MEMBERS OF THE VIRGINIA AND NORTH CAROLINA CHAPTERS OF THE ASSOCIATION OF PUBLIC-SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS OFFICIALS (APCO) BECAME INVOLVED IN THE MID-1980S. BY THE EARLY 1990S, THE NATIONAL APCO ORGANIZATION CONVINCED CONGRESS OF THE NEED FOR A FORMAL PROCLAMATION. REP. EDWARD J. MARKEY (D-MASS.) INTRODUCED WHAT BECAME H.J. RES. 284 TO CREATE "NATIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS WEEK." ACCORDING TO CONGRESSIONAL PROCEDURE, IT WAS INTRODUCED TWICE MORE IN 1993 AND 1994, AND THEN BECAME PERMANENT, WITHOUT THE NEED FOR YEARLY INTRODUCTION.



SYSTEM UPDATES: A NEW SPILLMAN SOFTWARE INTERFACE IS NOW ALLOWING THE GLOBE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO SEE THE LATEST CALL INFORMATION IN THEIR UNITS BY PROVIDING AUTOMATIC UPDATES FROM DISPATCH AT 20 SECOND INTERVALS. ADDITIONALLY, NEW MODULES WERE INSTALLED ON THE COMPUTER AIDED DISPATCH (CAD) SYSTEM THAT IS MAKING IT EASIER FOR DISPATCHERS TO ENTER INFORMATION THAT PREVIOUSLY WAS NOT EASILY ACCESSIBLE, SUCH AS PAWN SHOP TICKETS. DATA ENTRY IS TAKING 1/2 THE TIME! RADIO COMMUNICATIONS WERE ENHANCED WITH THE INSTALLATION OF C-SOFT, A RADIO FREQUENCY MANAGEMENT TOOL THAT ALLOWS DISPATCH TO CREATE TALK GROUPS ACROSS FREQUENCIES. THIS FUNCTION IS CUTTING DOWN ON RADIO TRAFFIC, ALLOWING SPECIALIZED RESPONDERS TO TALK TO EACH OTHER WHEN THERE IS NO NEED FOR DISPATCH TO MONITOR, FREEING UP DISPATCHERS AS THEY PERFORM ANY NUMBER OF THE MANY FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE.



DIVE TEAM

THE DIVE TEAM IS CALLED INTO SERVICE WHEN A BODY OR A PIECE OF EVIDENCE IS BELOW THE WATER'S SURFACE. THOUGH THIS DUTY IS VOLUNTARY AND MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT, THEY ARE ALWAYS READY TO RESPOND WHEN NEEDED. THE DIVE TEAM IS COMPRISED OF DEPUTIES AND DETENTION OFFICERS.

GILA COUNTY SHERIFF'S MOUNTED POSSE

FOR THE FIRST TIME IN GILA COUNTY HISTORY THE GILA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE HAS A CERTIFIED MOUNTED POSSE. THE MOUNTED POSSE CONSISTS OF DEPUTIES WHO HAVE COMPLETED THE ARIZONA POST ACADEMY FOR MOUNTED CROWD CONTROL. IN THE EVENT OF LARGE CROWDS THE MOUNTED POSSE IS AVAILABLE AND PREPARED TO KEEP THE ORDER. GILA COUNTY SHERIFF'S PAYSON POSSE

THIS GROUP DOES SECURITY DETAILS FOR EVENTS, GROUPS AND ORGANIZATIONS IN THE PAYSON AREA. THEY ALSO PROVIDE PRISONER TRANSPORT AND SUPPORT COURT OFFICERS AS NEEDED. AT THE REQUEST OF THE SHERIFF, THEY MAY ASSIST IN ALL TYPES OF SITUATIONS SUCH AS ROAD CLOSURES DURING A FOREST FIRE. GILA COUNTY SEARCH AND RESCUE (SAR)

BY ARIZONA REVISED STATUTE, THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE MUST PROVIDE SAR AVAILABILITY. GILA COUNTY HAS TWO UNITS: GILA COUNTY SEARCH AND RESCUE SOUTH TO THE ROOSEVELT BRIDGE AND TONTO RIM SEARCH AND RESCUE IN THE NORTHERN PART OF GILA COUNTY. BOTH UNITS ARE KEPT BUSY THROUGHOUT THE YEAR WITH TRAINING, SEARCHES, RESCUES AND COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES. GILA COUNTY SHERIFF'S RESERVE POSSE (SRP)

SRP PROVIDES SECURITY DETAILS FOR EVENTS, GROUPS AND ORGANIZATIONS. THEY ALSO PROVIDE PRISONER TRANSPORT AS WELL AS ASSIST WHEN NEEDED ON HIGH PROFILE TRIALS WITHIN THE COUNTY. ADDITIONALLY, SRP MEMBERS PROVIDE PATROL OPERATIONS TO THE MORE REMOTE AREAS OF GILA COUNTY BY UTILIZING FULLY MARKED PATROL VEHICLES IN CHERRY CREEK, HAYDEN, WINKELMAN, DRIPPING SPRINGS, ROOSEVELT AND THE PINAL MOUNTAINS. SHERIFF'S OFFICE CERT (COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM)

CERT MEMBERS GIVE CRITICAL SUPPORT TO FIRST RESPONDERS IN EMERGENCIES, PROVIDE IMMEDIATE ASSISTANCE TO VICTIMS, ORGANIZE SPONTANEOUS VOLUNTEERS AT A DISASTER SITE, AND COLLECT DISASTER INTELLIGENCE TO SUPPORT FIRST RESPONDER EFFORTS.
